4. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Conducting this investigation will be your primary duty until the investigation is submitted to the appointing authority. Your investigation will be conducted in accordance with AR 15-6, to determine the facts and circumstances as mentioned above. You will be guided by the procedures outlined in AR 15-6, and are appointed IAW 15-6, paragraph 2-1. For legal guidance and specifics on the subject investigation, consult with the Bde legal office, Fob Hammer at (b)(3), (b)(6) Your report of investigation will be submitted NLT 24 April 2008 to this Headquarters.

SUBJECT: Chronology of IED Strike on 08APR08

1. The following sequence of events occurred from the first report o/a 082030APR08:

082030APR08: Received call from TF1-10 TOC that Rock 6's CSD (Protector Element) had been struck by an IED in AO Blackhawk, East of Rustimayah Bridge, vic (b)(3).

082100APR08: Received call from Blackhawk 5 regarding casualties; 1xKIA, SSG Hartley, Jeffery 2xWIA, (b)(3), (b)(6) (SI), and (b)(3), (b)(6) (VSI).

- (b)(3), (b)(6) has shrapnel in hand, punctured cheek.
- (b)(3), (b)(6) had his left arm partially amputated below the elbow.

082115APR08: Received information from (b)(3), (b)(6), through medical channels, that casualties are being ground evacuated to FOB Rustimayah to be triaged. (b)(3), (b)(6) is SI and at FOB Rustimayah BSB TMC and (b)(3), (b)(6) is being evacuated to 86th CSII and seen by (b)(3), (b)(6) who will conduct surgery o/a 2200hrs. Will conduct surgery for 3-4hrs. He also has shrapnel in left inner thigh

082130APR08: Received call from Blackhawk 5 that 3-1CAV sent recovery patrol of QRF, EOD, Wrecker & M88 from Assassin.

082145APR08: 203rd (b)(3), (b)(6) confirmed they will handle cleaning of struck vehicle

082215APR08: (b)(3), (b)(6) is at COP Carver, but 2xmental health specialists are available
Struck vehicle arrived at FOB Hammer at 2230hrs

Narrative:

Team responded to a PBA at (b)(3) resulting in 1 KIA and 2 WIA. POC was Blackhawk X-ray. The UH-1H was traveling east on (b)(1)1.4a when it was struck by a 2 each copper EFP array. The configuration and speed of the convoy is unknown due to the personnel being evacuated from the area. The IED was concealed in a yellow burlap sack and placed 4 feet off the south side of the road next to a dirt mound with a light pole marker. The vehicle was travel in the center of the road placing it approximately 20 feet away from the detonation. The vehicle had the (b)(1)1.4a and (b)(1)1.4a systems on and operating. The firing circuit is unknown but believed to be cell phone armed PIR initiated. The (b)(1)1.4a and contained minimal fragmentation. The EFP penetrated the right front passenger door under the window and in between the front and rear passenger door causing it to be removed.

I, (b)(3), (b)(6), WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH ON 08 April 2008 AT APPROXIMATELY 2115. THE CSD CONVEY WAS TRAVELING EAST ON BRR. WITH MY SELF, (b)(3), (b)(6) AND (b)(3), (b)(6) APPROXIMATELY 5 MILES WEST OF 4 CORNERS WHEN THE LEAD TRUCK WITH SSG HARTLEY (b)(3), (b)(6) AND (b)(3), (b)(6) STRUCK AN IED LATER IDENTIFIED AS A 2 ARRAY EFP. UPON CONTACT THE VEHICLES PUSHED THROUGH THE DANGER AREA AND STOPPED. I IMMEDIATELY CALLED OVER THE RADIO FOR A SITREP FROM PROTECTOR 6 AND AFTER 2 FAILED RESPONSES EXITED THE VEHICLE AND RAN TO THE DISABLED TRUCK. I WAS THE 1ST RESPONDER ON THE SCENE AND BEGAN TO ASSESS THE SITUATION. (b)(3), (b)(6) HAD EXITED THE VEHICLE AND WAS VISIBLY CONFUSED, DISORIENTED, AND COMPLAINED OF LOSS OF VISION. THE VEHICLE BEGAN TO CATCH FIRE. I GUIDED (b)(3), (b)(6) TO ROCK 6'S VEHICLE. SAT HIM DOWN AND DESIGNATED THE AREA AS THE CCP. I RAN BACK TO THE DISABLED VEHICLE AND NOTICED (b)(3), (b)(6) STILL STANDING IN THE GUNNERS HATCH, SHIFTING FROM LEFT TO RIGHT. HE APPEARED TO BE DISORIENTED AND I ASSUMED HE WAS IN SHOCK. I REPEATED SEVERAL TIMES FOR HIM TO GET OUT OF THE VEHICLE STATING IT WAS ON FIRE. HE WAS UNRESPONSIVE OR UNABLE TO HEAR ME. I PULLED HIM OUT OF THE GUNNERS HATCH THROUGH THE DRIVERS SIDE REAR DOOR. ONCE HE WAS ON THE GROUND I ATTEMPTED TO DRAG HIM TO THE CCP AS I YANKED ON THE REAR HAND HOLD OF THE VEST. THE VEST SLIPPED OFF HIS BODY. I AGAIN ATTEMPTED TO DRAG (b)(3), (b)(6) TO THE CCP BUT DUE TO (b)(3), (b)(6) SIZE WAS UNABLE TO BY MYSELF. (b)(3), (b)(6) DESIGNATED MEDIC WITH THE CONVEY ARRIVED TO ASSIST BUT ALSO WAS UNABLE TO PROVIDE ENOUGH STRENGTH. I YELLED FOR HELP AND (b)(3), (b)(6) QUICKLY ARRIVED AND WE WERE ABLE TO PULL HIM BACK TO THE CCP. I RAN BACK AGAIN TO ASSIST SSG HARTLEY. WHEN I REACHED THE TC'S SIDE THE DOOR WAS HANGING OFF AND I WAS ABLE TO SEE THAT SSG HARTLEY WAS KIA. I CHECKED FOR SIGNS OF RESPONSIVENESS AND A PULSE TO MAKE SURE MY INITIAL ASSESSMENT WAS CORRECT. HE WAS UNRESPONSIVE AND HAD NO PULSE. HE WAS SLUMPED OVER TOWARDS THE MIDDLE OF THE TRUCK. (b)(6) HE DID NOT SURVIVE. AFTER DETERMINING THAT SSG HARTLEY WAS GONE I RAN BACK TO ROCK 6'S TRUCK AND RETRIEVED THE FIRE EXTINGUISHER, RAN BACK TO THE DISABLED TRUCK AND EXTINGUISHED THE FIRE IN THE FRONT, ON TOP OF THE RADIO MOUNT, AND THE REAR NEAR THE CREW SERVE AMMO. ONCE THE FIRE WAS OUT I VISUALLY INSPECTED THE VEHICLE TO ASSESS THE VEHICLE FOR RECOVERY. NEAR THE RIGHT REAR TIRE I NOTICED SSG HARTLEY'S (b)(6) I PICKED IT UP AND PLACED IT IN THE VEHICLE. I REPEATED A SITREP TO ROCK 6 OF MY ACTIONS UP TO THIS POINT, CHECKED ON THE CASUALTIES AND WENT BACK WITH (b)(3), (b)(6) TO THE DISABLED VEHICLE TO RECOVER AS MANY SENSITIVE ITEMS THAT WE COULD FIND. I AGAIN WENT BACK TO ROCK 6'S TRUCK TO (b)(6), (b)(3) WHO WAS MONITORING THE NET, AND RELAYING RADIO TRAFFIC TO RECEIVE A SITREP OF RECOVERY ASSETS, MEDIVAC STATUS, AND SUPPORTING UNITS IN THE AO. SOMETIME DURING MY PREVIOUS ACTIONS, I DO NOT RECALL EXACTLY WHEN, SUPPORTING UNITS ARRIVED ON SCENE, ESTABLISHED ADDITIONAL SECURITY AROUND THE SITE, PROVIDED ADDITIONAL MEDICAL SUPPORT FOR THE CASUALTIES, AND COORDINATED RECOVERY ASSETS, AND WAS EVACUATED THE 2 WOUNDED SOLDIERS TO RUSTAMIYA. ONCE I DETERMINED THAT THE RECOVERY AND CAS EVAC WERE HANDLED, I CHECKED ON EACH INDIVIDUAL CSD TRUCK TO ENSURE THEY WERE MONITORING PROPER SECTORS OF FIRE, AND THE STATUS OF PERSONAL AND SENSITIVE ITEMS. ONCE THE CASUALTIES WERE EVACUED AND THE VEHICLE WAS RECOVERED, WE FELL IN WITH THE SUPPORTING UNIT AND WE WERE ESCORTED BACK TO FOB HAMMER. (b)(3), (b)(6) TRUCK FOLLOWED THE ESCORT UNIT TO MORTUARY AFFAIRS TO RECOVERY ANY ADDITIONAL SENSITIVE ITEMS. RECOVERY WAS UNSUCCESSFUL. UPON RETURN TO THE CP, (b)(3), (b)(6) REPORTED THAT (b)(3), (b)(6) WAS TASKED WITH RECOVERY AND SIGNING FOR ANY SENSITIVE ITEMS LEFT IN THE TRUCK.

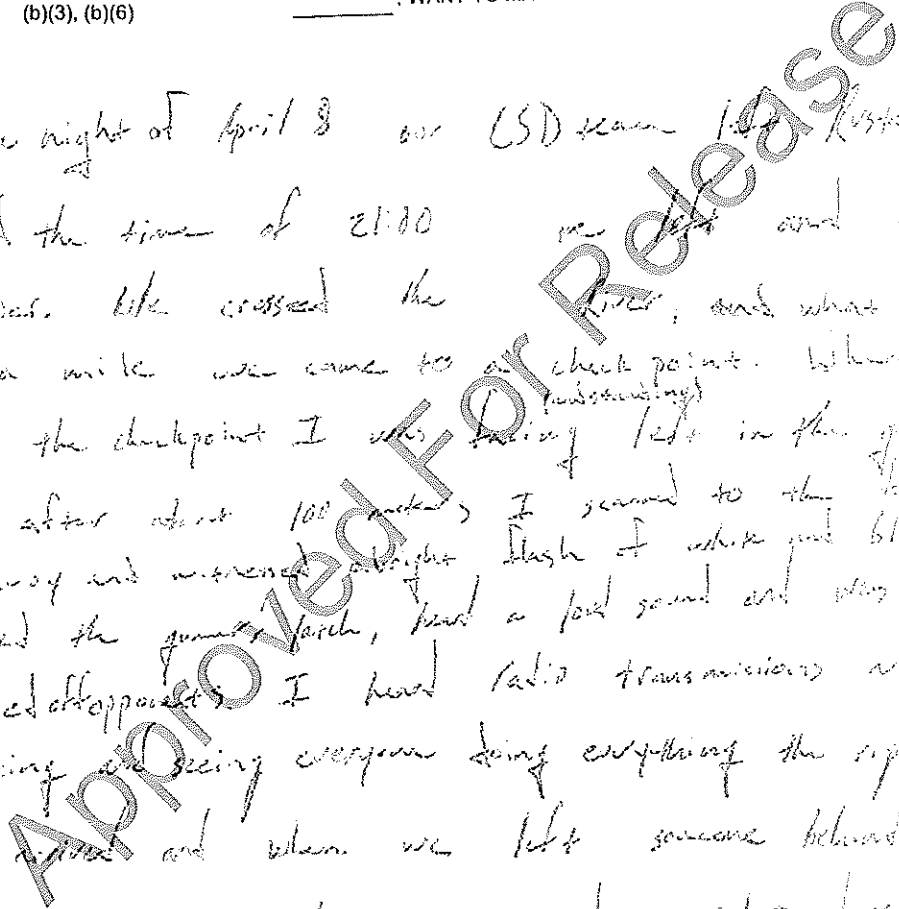

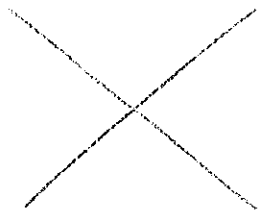

On the night of Tuesday the 5th of April 2008 HNB 1-10 CAD left Rustumja through the gates. We traveled till we got just passed the bridge. I was looking out the passenger rear window where I was sitting when I saw what looked like fireworks go off beside the lead truck. I continued to watch as the truck continued to roll a couple feet before it came to a halt. I was in second truck so we pulled forward to about even when I heard someone scream medic. I reached for my aide bag and pulled the lock on the door asking if it was safe. We pulled forward more and (b)(3), (b)(6) told me I could go. I ran out of the truck toward the hit truck. I saw the driver (b)(3), (b)(6) trying to get out of the truck. As I came up to him to assess his injuries he told me he couldn't see. I had noticed that he had blood oozed over his eyelashes making his eye shut so I reached out and unstuck his eyelashes. He told me he could see and to go. I had noticed some (b)(6) and a (b)(6) but I continued on to assess the other casualties. I ran around the front of the truck while (b)(3), (b)(6) pulled security. The damage to the right side of the vehicle was severe. I noticed SSG Hartley and I knew with the damages sustained to his body that he was already dead. With no way to open the rear right door I ran around the rear of the truck to assess the gunner (b)(3), (b)(6). He was still standing but wasn't responding to my prompting. (b)(3), (b)(6) reached into the truck and pulled (b)(3), (b)(6) down into the rear seat then out onto the road. (b)(3), (b)(6) and I tried to pull (b)(3), (b)(6) to the other truck where (b)(3), (b)(6) was. I wasn't strong enough to help (b)(3), (b)(6) so he called for more help. (b)(3), (b)(6)

I cut (b)(3), (b)(6) shoelaces unlaced his boots and started cutting up his left pant leg. There was clumps of something that could have been muscle or tissue around the bottom of his pants but I kept going until I got all the way up his leg. I noticed the shrapnel imbedded in his leg and knew to leave it but I knew the (b)(3), (b)(6) in his leg had to be packed. (b)(3), (b)(6) handed me his tourniquet and I applied the tourniquet to (b)(3), (b)(6) upper left leg. I grabbed at the kerlix still in the IFAK from (b)(3), (b)(6) and proceeded to pack (b)(3), (b)(6) wounds when I was done I finished by wrapping the remainder of the kerlix around the wound site and taping it down. Right before we get to the Aide station the other medic handed me the Narcan and told me to push it. Someone had called her (b)(3), (b)(6) so I listened and pushed 4mg of Narcan when we finally reached the Aidestation and let the back down they started pulling (b)(3), (b)(6) out of the MIVRAP. I went after running behind the letter into the aidestation. As they ran to the back, they refused to let me go with either (b)(3), (b)(6) or (b)(3), (b)(6). SECTION IV - FINDINGS (para 3-10, AR 15-6)

The (investigating officer) (board) , having carefully considered the evidence, finds:

On 09 APR 2008, TF1-10 CSD took (b)(3), (b)(6) to a memorial service held at FOB Rustimayah for a 2-69AR Soldier. At approximately 2030hrs, the CSD platoon left FOB Rustimayah travelling East towards FOB Hammer on Route Thoroughbred at about 53 k/jh. Just after the patrol crossed the Rustimayah bridge, vic (b)(3) an IED struck the lead vehicle of the patrol. This vehicle contained (b)(3), (b)(6) and SSG Hartley. The IED was a multi-arrayed EFP with PIR initiation. The EFP entered the vehicle from the right to left, hitting SSG Hartley first and resulting in him being KIA. The explosion caused shrapnel to enter (b)(3), (b)(6) left inner thigh and partially amputate his left arm below the elbow. Final debris punctured (b)(3), (b)(6) right cheek and some shrapnel hit his right hand. IAW S.O.P., the second vehicle in the convoy pulled forward approximately 200 meters while the 3rd and 4th vehicle remained behind the struck vehicle, spaced out across 400 meters. Soldiers from the third vehicle went to the struck vehicle to assist (b)(3), (b)(6) and (b)(3), (b)(6) in getting out of the vehicle. Ground evacuation was deemed the appropriate method due to closeness to FOB Rustimayah (b)(3), (b)(6) administered immediate aid as the first responder. (b)(3), (b)(6) and (b)(3), (b)(6) were ground evacuated to FOB Rustimayah. SSG Hartley's vehicle and SSG Hartley's remains were returned to FOB Hammer where (b)(3), (b)(6) and (b)(3), (b)(6) made positive identification.
