SUBJECT: Appointment as Investigating Officer under AR 15-6

1. You are hereby appointed as an Investigating Officer pursuant to *AR 15-6, Procedures for Investigating Officers and Boards of Officers*, to conduct an investigation into the facts and circumstances surrounding the death of PFC Cameron K Payne on 11 June 2007.
2. You will issue Findings and Recommendations that cover the following areas of inquiry:
 - a. Determine the medical cause of the Soldier's death.
 - b. Determine the uniform and protective equipment the Soldier.
 - c. Identify the information briefed regarding this type of enemy threat activity prior to the mission that the Soldier was on.
 - d. Describe the mission that the Soldier was engaged in.
 - e. Assess the duration in time from the initial wounding until the Soldiers' arrival at the aid station.
 - f. Identify any other relevant matters that you discover in the course of investigating these allegations.
3. Your legal advisor is (b)(3)(b)(6) 2nd Brigade Operational Law Team, VOI (b)(3)(b)(6) (b)(3)(b)(6), who will give you an in-brief before you begin your investigation and be available to assist you during the investigation.
4. You may speak with any and all individuals that you believe have information pertinent to your investigation. You will obtain guidance from your legal advisor if in the course of your investigation you determine that completion thereof requires examining the conduct or performance of, or may result in Findings and Recommendations adverse to, a person senior to yourself.
5. If during the course of your investigation you come to suspect that an individual you are questioning may have committed a crime, you will advise that individual of his or her rights

SUBJECT: 15-6 findings of death of PFC Payne, Cameron K.; (b)(3)(b)(6)

1. Summary. On 11 June 2007 at approximately 1314 hours, fourth platoon of Delta, 2-16 IN BN SP'd from FOB Rustamiyah on a combat patrol. PFC Payne was serving as the gunner in the second vehicle of a four-vehicle convoy. The convoy was enroute from FOB Rustamiyah to the Ranger JSS (COP Cajimat) when the convoy was attacked by a command-wire detonated, multiple arrayed copper explosively formed penetrator (EFP) at grid MB 55574 87570 on/around 1355 hours. This attack resulted in one (1) damaged M1151 and two wounded United States Soldiers. PFC Payne was the most seriously injured Soldier who sustained a severe shrapnel wound to the head. At 1407 hours, PFC Payne was ground evacuated to FOB Loyalty. At 1417 hours, the convoy arrived at Loyalty and proceeded to the hospital where he was stabilized and air evacuated to the CSH. PFC Payne underwent emergency surgery at the CSH to relieve swelling of his brain. PFC Payne was pronounced dead at 2115 hours on 11 June 2007.

2. Findings. I find that neither PFC Payne nor any member of the convoy at fault for neither the event nor wounds that he sustained which ultimately led to his death. The vehicle damage, injuries inflicted, and ultimately the death of PFC Payne was a result of AIF actions. PFC Payne was wearing the proper PPE (IBA, Esapi plates, Side plates, ACH, eye protection, and DAPS) when the incident occurred. He was sitting down, i.e., at neck defilade, while serving as the gunner.

E. Summary of incident: 111330JUN07 4TH PLATOON, COMPANY D, 2-16IN WAS STRUCK BY AN EFP VIC MB 556 875. THE EFP WENT OFF IN FRONT OF THE SECOND VEHICLE (D6) IN THE CONVOY. THE CONVOY WAS STOPPED WHEN A CASUALTY WAS IDENTIFIED. THE GUNNER IN THE D6 VEHICLE HAD TAKEN SHRAPNEL WOUNDS TO THE FACE AND HEAD AND WAS BLEEDING PROFUSELY. THE PLATOON MEDIC CAME UP FROM THE REAR VEHICLE TO ASSESS THE CASUALTY. THE OTHER VEHICLES BEGAN PULLING SECURITY WITH THE MOUNTED WEAPONS SYSTEMS AND DISMOUNTED PERSONNEL. THE PLATOON TOOK SNIPER FIRE FROM THE NORTH WEST, BUT COULD NOT PID ANY ENEMY PERSONNEL. THE DISMOUNTS, INSTEAD, FIRED SUPPRESSION SHOTS IN THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF THE ENEMY THREAT. WHEN THE CASUALTY WAS LOADED BACK INTO THE VEHICLE, THE PLATOON BEGAN MOVEMENT TO FOB LOYALTY. AT VIC MB 546 871, THE TRUCK CARRYING THE CASUALTY DIED. THE CASUALTY WAS TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER VEHICLE, PERSONNEL WERE CROSSLOADED, AND TWO VEHICLES CONTINUED THE CASEVAC PROCESS TO FOB LOYALTY, WHILE TWO VEHICLES STAYED (ONE DOWN, AND ONE FOR SECURITY). COMPANY A CAME TO RECOVER THE BROKEN DOWN VEHICLE AND THE REST OF THE CONVOY MADE IT TO FOB LOYALTY WITH NO FURTHER INCIDENTS.

On 11 JUN 07, our convoy was conducting a JSS Personnel Changeover Mission and escorting the Chaplain to company COPS. After a thorough route analysis, we decided that a combination of (b)(7)(F) threats. As we were turning off of main berm road onto the road just north of R.assa, an IED went off in the field/yard in front of the mosque on that corner. At first, I thought there were no injuries, and I stopped the convoy to try and cordon the area and mosque. I then looked up and noticed that my gunner was bleeding from the head. We maneuvered the vehicles into a tight perimeter and began giving aid to the casualty. We attempted to put him on a spineboard. We put him in the rear seat of my vehicle and started driving toward FOB Loyalty. My vehicle died on RTE Florida, and we transferred the casualty to (b)(3)(b)(6) vehicle. Then his vehicle and (b)(3)(b)(6) vehicle continued on to FOB Loyalty as my vehicle and (b)(3)(b)(6) vehicle stayed to guard the downed vehicle. During the incident, the gunner was sitting down. The IED strike occurred vic. MB 556 875 at approx. 1330. The truck died (b)(3)(b)(6) and the casualty was transferred vehicles vic. MB 548 871. The casualty arrived at FOB Loyalty approx. 20 minutes after the incident. NOTHING FOLLOWS.

That 4th platoon came down Inner Burn Rel around 19:00. Platoon made a left and the second track was hit by an RPG. The track kept rolling for a few meters, my track, 4th in control of movement, started pulling security. IC of Green 44 tried to use the mines, however we had no comms. At 01:46 I signaled us to his track, then I was told that PFC Payne was hit and losing blood. To get out of track we went to 46, open doors and proceeded to pull Payne out of the track. Got Payne out and started to take CBA off, but we took sniper fire. I then proceeded to manage blood loss. Manual wounds on left eye, left side of mouth, shoulder and back were not. When blood was under control put Payne in 46 and sent off to hospital. 100 meters or so down the road 46 died. Moved Payne to 43 and sent to hospital. At my hospital returned to control blood and assess wounds. Payne had pulse and was breathing all the way to the hospital at FOB Loyalty. When he arrived someone took him and FOB Loyalty hospital assumed responsibility of PFC Payne. — End of Report
