COL Dan Enslen received his commission from Georgia College and State University as an Armor officer in 1999. His previous assignments include Tank Platoon Leader, Scout Platoon Leader, and Assistants Operations Officer for 3rd Squadron, 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment (Fort Carson, CO).
