MAJOR GENERAL DAVID C. HILL

Deputy Commanding General, U.S. Army Central

Major General David C. Hill assumed duties as the Deputy Commanding General of U.S. Army Central (USARCENT) on June 7, 2018. Hailing from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, he received his commission in 1990 from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York, graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry. He also holds a Master of Science degree in Engineering Management from the University of Missouri-Rolla and a Master of Science degree in National Security Strategy from the National War College. Major General Hill is a certified Project Management Professional.

Prior to becoming the Deputy Commanding General of USARCENT, Major General Hill commanded the Transatlantic Division of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) in Winchester, Virginia, providing engineering and construction services across the U.S. Central Command Area of Responsibility. He also commanded the Southwestern Division, USACE, which is headquartered in Dallas, Texas. Other command assignments include the 36th Engineer Brigade, Fort Hood, Texas; Brigade Special Troops Battalion, 1st Brigade Combat Team (BCT), 4th Infantry Division (ID), Fort Hood, Texas; and Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 16th Engineer Battalion, 1st Armored Division Engineer Brigade, Bad Kreuznach and Giessen, Germany.

Some of his more recent staff assignments include Director of the Office of the Chief of Engineers in the Pentagon, Washington, D.C.; Maneuver Support Human Resource Manager, U.S. Army Colonels Management Office, Rosslyn, Virginia; Division Chief of Training and Chief of Operations, 4th ID at Fort Hood, Texas; and Combat Engineer Observer/Controller, National Training Center, Fort Irwin, California.

Major General Hill's assignments also include the 37th Engineer Battalion, 20th Engineer Brigade, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Joint Special Operations Command, Pope Air Force Base, North Carolina; 299th Engineer Battalion, 1st BCT, 4th ID, Fort Hood, Texas. His operational assignments include Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm, Operation Joint Endeavor and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Major General Hill's awards and decorations include two Distinguished Service Medals, two Legions of Merit, three Bronze Star Medals, five Meritorious Service Medals, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, four Army Commendation Medals, six Army Achievement Medals, the Master Parachutist Badge, the Air Assault Badge and the Army Staff Identification Badge.
