15 October 06	2200: Received WARNO from (b)(3), (b)(6) that I would be conducting a 15-6 informal investigation on a CF KIA with the 57th MP CO that occurred circa three days previous. I was also advised that I would be mentoring another (b)(3), (b)(6) in the completion of his 15-6. Orders will be directly from Brigade. I was also advised not to commence the investigation until after the units ceremony for the soldier.
16 October 06	I recovered the CCIR and storyboard of the incident. I am still awaiting orders from Brigade.
20 October 06	I went to the 57th MP CO TOC and briefed (b)(3), (b)(6) on my appointment, as well as offered my condolences. I also allowed him to read my appointment order. (b)(3), (b)(6) indicated that cursory efforts to obtain Sworn Statements et al had begun after last evenings ceremony. (b)(3), (b)(6) indicated that (b)(3), (b)(6) is the (b)(3), (b)(6) for the element that was attacked. I met with (b)(3), (b)(6) and briefed him up as I had (b)(3), (b)(6). I asked that Sworn Statements and Privacy Act Statements be taken from anyone with first hand knowledge of the attack. (b)(3), (b)(6) indicated that I could pick up the completed Sworn Statements and Privacy Act Statements at 0900 on 21 October 06. ** (b)(3), (b)(6) in the GT attacked is presently in Hawaii convalescing, I will call (b)(3), (b)(6) to determine if her statement et al are imperative.
21 October 06	I went to the 57th MP CO TOC at 0900 to pick up the Sworn Statements et al as instructed by (b)(3), (b)(6) was not there and no information was left there for me. I was told that (b)(3), (b)(6) would be in that afternoon. //////////////////////////////////////next page////////////////////////////////////

<p>21 October 06</p>	<p>1600: After several attempts to linkup with (b)(3), (b)(6) finally located him (b)(3), (b)(6) handed this writer 6 Privacy Act Statements and requested a couple more blank copies.                  1605: I provide (b)(3), (b)(6) a blank copy of a Privacy Act Statement and reiterated my request for that any person having first hand knowledge of the attack should complete a Sworn Statement and Privacy Act Statement. (b)(3), (b)(6) assured this writer that the requested information would be completed and ready for pick up at the 57th TOC NLT 221200LOCT 06.</p>
<p>22 October 06</p>	<p>1500: I went to the 57th TOC and recovered the aforementioned documents (20 pages (10 front and back)</p>
<p>22 October 06</p>	<p>1600: I sent an e-mail to (b)(3), (b)(6) RFI: Are the Sworn Statement and Privacy Act Statement of (b)(3), (b)(6) of the GT attacked, an imperative prior to completing this investigation. Subsequent telephone conversation with (b)(3), (b)(6) in this issue indicated that the aforementioned statements were desired but not required. Due to time constraints and having sufficient basis for findings and recommendations I will complete the investigation at this time.</p>

## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: 15-6 Investigation on Stanton, Kenny F. Jr., (b)(3), (b)(6) (KIA)

1. The following is a memorandum for record into the 15-6 Investigation conducted by (b)(3), (b)(6) into the matter of Kenny F. Stanton, SSN: (b)(3), (b)(6) KIA on 13 October 2006.

2. Investigation into this matter has established the following findings of fact:

On 132110COCT06 Centurion 1-2, consisting of vehicles 57-121, 57-124, 57-133, and 57-134, were conducting an authorized mounted patrol in the Kadhimiyah District. (See Exhibit II, pages 1, 3, and 5).

While traveling on Route Mets elements of Centurion 1-2 observed suspicious activity to wit: "two IP patrol vehicles escorting a black BMW behind our convoy", after being detected the aforementioned suspicious turned off onto Creek Road, turned off the running lights and disappeared. (See Exhibits X and XII).

Given the foregoing suspicious activity the Centurion 1-2 element turned onto Creek Road heading East. (See Exhibit II, pages 1, 3, 5, and 6).

At 132057COCT06 Centurion 1-2 Gun Truck 57-133 was struck on the drivers side with what is believed to have been an IED / EFP. (See Exhibit II, pages 5, 6, 7, and 8).

The driver of 57-133, Kenny F. Stanton was KIA "immediately", due to "explosive trauma" to the mandible and throat. (See Exhibit III, pages 1, 2, and 3. Exhibit IV, page 1. Exhibit XII).

The (b)(3), (b)(6) and (b)(3), (b)(6) were administered first aid and Centurion 1-1 ground MEDEVAC said personnel to the 10th CSH. (See Exhibit II, pages 2, 3, and 5. Exhibit X, Exhibit XII, Exhibit XIV, Exhibit XVI, Exhibit XVIII, and Exhibit XX).

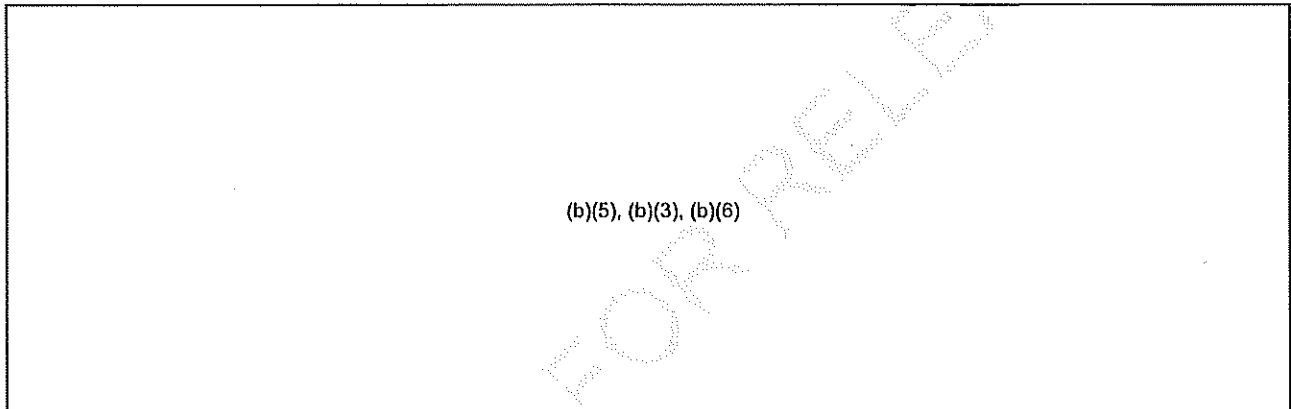

Centurion 1-2 set up a cordon to support recovery operations and MEDEVAC. (See Exhibits VI, VIII, XIV, XVI, XVIII, and XX.)

All soldiers in the attacked vehicle, (57-133), et al were wearing all PPE. (See Exhibit IV, pages 1, 2, and 4. Exhibits VI, VIII, XIV, XVI, XX, XXII, and XXIV).

All IED defeat jamming system were operational and engaged ( (b)(1)1.4a )

You are appointed an investigating officer pursuant to AR 15-6, para. 2-1(a)(3) to investigate the facts and circumstances surrounding the KIA of a Soldier belonging to 57th Military Police Company on 13 October 2006. This is your primary duty and takes precedence over all other assigned duties until completed.

2. Upon receipt of this order, IAW AR 15-6 you shall consult with your legal advisor (b)(3), (b)(6) (b)(3), (b)(6) at (b)(3), (b)(6) or (b)(3), (b)(6) to develop an investigation plan and obtain forms and regulations.

3. In addition to determining the facts and circumstances of this incident, your investigation shall specifically determine:

- a. Were standard operation procedures used during the incident?
- b. Were appropriate safeguards in place to prevent the incident?

4. When conducting your investigation, follow the informal procedures outlined in AR 15-6. Record and swear all witness statements on DA Form 2823. Provide each witness a Privacy Act statement. Prior to questioning any person whom you suspect has violated the any law, you must advise that person of his or her rights under Article 31, UCMJ, using DA Form 3881. Consult with legal counsel before any rights advisement.

5. Make specific findings and recommendations to assist me in determining the proper disposition of these allegations. Cite the statements that support your findings. State who you believe and why, if there is conflicting evidence. Provide an index and tab one copy for your report. Submit your report on DA Form 1574 to me within five days of receipt of this appointment. Extensions must be requested in writing from me and state the reason for delays

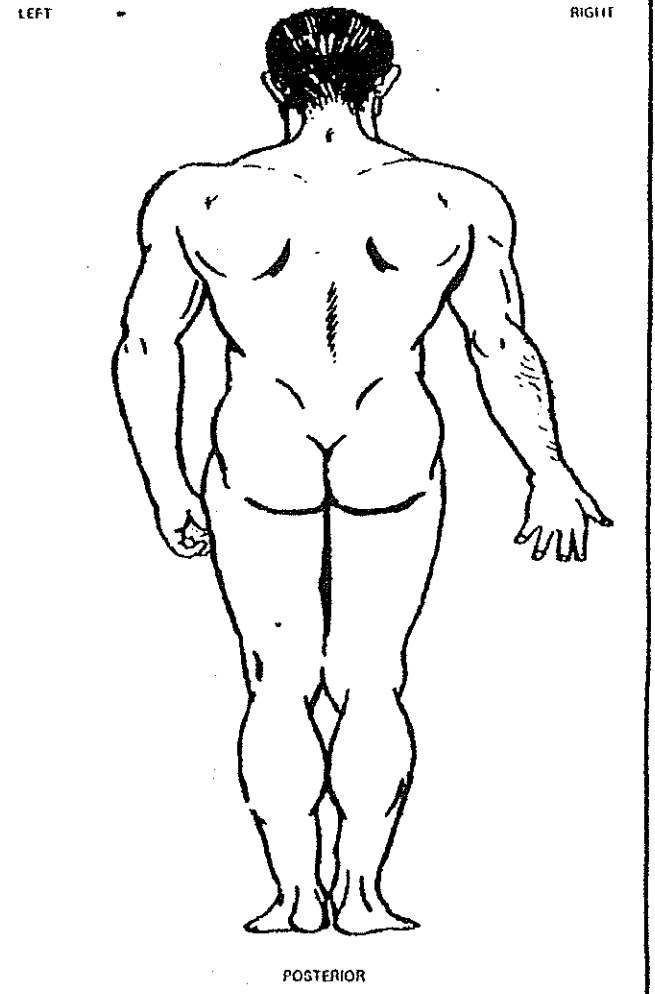
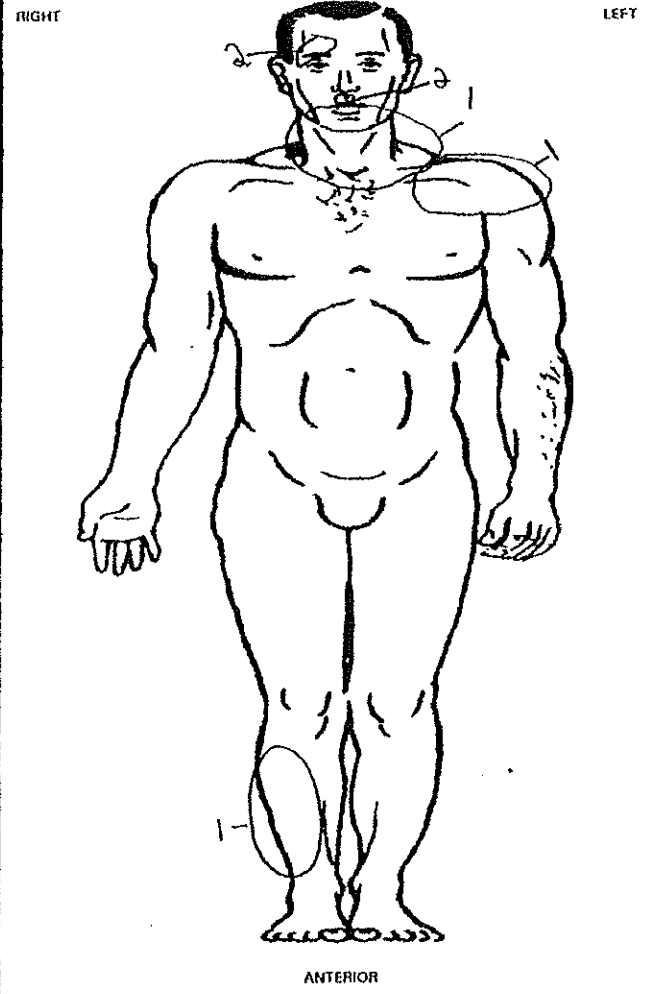



Quickly after, the two patrol vehicles escorting the BMW turned left going to the other side of "Shit Creek". They went about 300 meters away to our left hand side when the IP vehicles turned off their light bars. that's when we lost sight of them. Trying to look for them our convoy did an "u-turn" on Mets, the whole road was very dark. When about 200 meters into the road, in front of an open area to our right side the third vehicle was hit by an IED from the left side. The explosion sent shrapnel to our vehicle and the pressure moved us, my driver (b)(3), (b)(6) then stopped to recover himself and to see what was going on.
