

Answer: I was asleep in my CHU. I was awoken by the very loud sound of the one-way. Followed quickly by the impact and explosion. I fell off of my bed and braced for another possible impact. I then heard the screaming outside. I heard people yelling "Bunkers". The next thing I remember was running over smolder debris, making it to the nearest bunker by the JORSOF CHU area. Myself, some members of the JORSOF, and _____. We heard the calls over the LRAD repeating "Bunkers". We heard the LRAD call "Fracture". We heard the LRAD call "All Clear". From there, _____ and myself ran to the POI. I instructed the two I was with to go and report to their team leaders. I then ran to where I could access the POI. I then happened upon SGT Rivers. The _____ and another individual were attempting to move him onto the litter. Seeing the condition he was in and that there were already two with SGT Rivers, I began to search for _____

any possible casualties or people who may have been trapped. Finding none, I made my way toward surrounding CHUs, checking on anyone I recognized to ensure nobody else was injured or needed help. That's when _____ found me (my Squad Leader). Our squad of men were manning the towers and he told me they were okay and accounted for. I eventually made my way over to the chapel to see what I could do to help. I began passing out water and checking on more of our men. At some point "Bunkers" was called again, just before 0730. Once "All Clear", we occupied our staging area outside of the chapel. Eventually a team was called up to go and assist EOD to clear debris, bios and search for possible components of the UAS for EOD to collect and analyze. That took several hours. I eventually ate lunch, got ready for my shift, and conducted my responsibilities as I normally do. _____



MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Phone Interview of [REDACTED] on 191640FEB2024.

1. On 19FEB2024, I spoke with [REDACTED] on the telephone for a follow-up conversation. I advised him that I was an Investigating Officer conducting an inquiry into the 28JAN attack at Tower 22. During our conversation, [REDACTED] told me the following things regarding the Scan Eagle antenna:

a. [REDACTED]

b. After the attack on 28JAN, the crew launched the daytime Scan Eagle and noticed the antenna was not functioning properly. The antenna was pointing up and to the East, not tracking the UAV, and most of the cables were stuck in the rotating arm. It appeared the gears were locked up as if something had pushed it. [REDACTED] did not notice any new damage to the antenna itself.


c. As of 19FEB2024, the antenna is fully operational. The crew replaced the quickfit motor and two cables.

d. The antenna is situated on top of an 8ft CONEX and extends an additional 30ft in the air.

My name is [REDACTED] I arrived at Tower 22 in [REDACTED] and I am projected to complete my current tour i [REDACTED] I am the [REDACTED]. I work mostly noon to midnight and have other manager responsibilities that cause me to work a flex schedule.

What does your typical day as a [REDACTED] for SCAN EAGLE Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) consist of?
Pass Down, weather report, Mission Readiness Report, managerial meetings, and checking on the maintenance and flight operations of the SCAN EAGLE for both day and night crews.

What is the relationship between ATG and Tower 22 for SCAN EAGLE operations? Any areas of friction that need to be addressed post-28 JAN 24 attack on Tower 22?

We are directed to conduct two, ten-hour flights per 24 hours in support of ATG operations. We mostly fly in support of smuggling operations near ATG. While communication has improved since the attack on 28 JAN 2024, there are still some challenges with dynamic tasking and flight take-off and recovery times with [REDACTED] (NFI, possibly ATG S2) at ATG.

Have you witnessed Electro-magnetic interference (EMI) at Tower 22, and has this activity affected SCAN EAGLE operations? Has SCAN EAGLE incorporated any technology to detect or defeat these transmissions?

Yes- there was an increase in EMI after 28 JAN 2024, mostly Command and Control (C2) disruption. Now the EMI is mostly ground GPS disruption as we conduct pre-flight checks. Within the Thunder Dome (ROZ for SCAN EAGLE operations in support of ATG), most EMI occurs at 8,000 feet elevation or In recovery from East to West. [REDACTED] (NFI) in the BDOC knows about an antennas that was found recently. However, over year ago outside the perimeter of Tower 22 East to West side It was found a tree-like structure to the east that was emitting signals. As far as protection, SCAN EAGLE is experimenting with Agile Meridian GPS detection system (AGM). Once it is fully operational, it should be able to detect where EMI is originating from.

What is your view of the communications between the BDOC, Tower 22, and SCAN EAGLE Operations? Has the communication improved since the attack on 28 JAN 2024?

Communication has improved across the base between ITC, JTAC (both at ATG) and the BDOC. One area that needs improvement is the communication between ATG and T22 over MIRC. As Scaneagle we take all our orders from MIRC and have to prioritize whats its being pass to us. If the task in MIRC was incorrect the problem doesn't come from Scaneagle. The communication breaks down from Mirc with ATG and T22 and thats something they need to adjust.

Describe your shift the day of the One-Way Unmanned Aerial Vehicle attack on Tower 22, Kingdom of Jordan, 28 JAN 2024.

I was in my CHU asleep when I heard the UAS. I thought it was our SCAN EAGLE landing the wrong way, so I left my CHU and made my way to the SCAN EAGLE compound. It sounded like a low RPM engine and I thought it was probably below 2000 feet and descending. I heard the explosion and knew it was a one-way attack UAS. I immediately helped [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] get ready for the next flight of SCAN EAGLE but there was C2 and GPS interference occurring on the ground and we were unable to launch early. I think Tower 22 called "BUNKERS" 2-3 times between the explosion and the 0700L SCAN EAGLE launch that morning.

See imagery and sketch of my assessed approach of the Enemy UAS attack on Tower 22 on 28 January 2024 and approximate location of the EMI antennae found outside of the perimeter on Tower 22 approximately one year ago. This statement was taken at Tower 22, Kingdom of Jordan, on 08 FEB 2024.







A7: Several FAAD operators attended a FAAD class at Fort Drum, all personnel attended a general CUAS class at Fort Drum. After these, [REDACTED] in our Brigade ADAM Cell) was responsible for facilitating training at Fort Drum. The training by [REDACTED] was half-hearted and provided no value to any of our crews, due to his lack of involvement and disrespectful attitude when asked additional questions. Then we had an MRX in May/June of 2023 led by [REDACTED] from TF Saber, which gave site specific details and training. At Kuwait we attended Green Sands (run by ARCENT), which was general and mostly unhelpful. At ATG, [REDACTED] ran our RIP and training, expanding upon our learning at the MRX and preparing us for the CJ36 certification team from CJTF-OIR. Quarterly the CJ36 team came and ran additional "certification" which was an inadequate, outdated, and unenthusiastic waste of time, typically the scenarios they provided were nowhere near anything realistic that any outstation had ever experienced and the team was less knowledgeable than even my least enthusiastic BDOC crew member.

A8: During the MRX and on site training during RIP, we rehearsed all FAAD related battle drills (OWUAS, IDF, Skynet, Mustang, Bunker). During the CJ36 certification we ran through the OWUAS and IDF drills as well.

A9: Prior to every shift, I run my crew through 30 minutes on the CDS3 training computer. We go through multiple FAAD related battle drills- react to OWUAS, react to IDF, and multiple combinations and variations of these events.

Q10: What, if any, tracks did you pick up on the morning on 28 January 2024? Please be specific as to location, time, and description of the tracks.

A10: At 0720c we picked up a track on the [REDACTED] to our Northeast, heading directly towards ATG. A few minutes prior, one of our partner force COPs reported hearing a UAS flying overhead moving towards ATG. I verified that the track was not IFFing any mode codes and told the FAAD operator to mark it hostile. We then proceeded to move through our OWUAS battle drill and concluded by engaging and destroying the OWUAS approximately 10km to our East. No other notable tracks were identified that morning.

Raid Operator, ITC, and COP Manager operate specific equipment/information reception and dissemination. They report directly to the Battle Staff. In OWUAS events the Raid Operator pushes out messages via PTT, the ITC sends out Net Calls on FM and keeps friendly ISR out of the BDZ, and the COP Manager logs and reports, building the COP.

The two FAAD Operators control the BDOC and Sentinel FAADs.

The EOC has it's own [REDACTED] FAAD Operator, and RTO. They control [REDACTED] and in CUAS events they receive commands to utilize Kinetic assets at the command of the [REDACTED] or GFC.

A14: Typically about once every month each of the three shifts of BDOC crews rotate "to the right" to the next time block. For example, after a month on Nights ([REDACTED]), my crew rotated to the Morning shift [REDACTED]. Day to day we have three crews running 8 hour shifts.


A21: I believe that in order to understand operations at T22 and how it relates to ATG. One of the Section Leaders from one of the Maneuver Troops, Alpine or Crazyhorse, should be interviewed. They have a unique perspective on T22's BDOC.

Q22: Is there anything that was not discussed above that you feel we should know?



What differences have you observed in the conduct of the SCAN EAGLE operations and interactions with the BDOC since the attack on Tower 22 on 28JAN24?

We used to only alert the BDOC when we started the engine. The 1st night after the attack this caused a panic here and they called for bunkers. We are still figuring out what this process looks like, but it is dictated by the BDOC. Currently we tell them when we start walking out to the bird and then when we start up the engine. For recovery we let the BDOC know when we start to return to base, when we are beginning recovery, and then when the bird is safe on deck. I prefer to use SVOIP to call the BDOC to ensure they understand the timeline, but we also put the updates in MIRC chat. We are still refining the process though. I think this is a good procedure right now to help with anxiety.

Describe the evening of the attack on Tower 22 (27-28JAN24).

My shift was a normal night. The launch was routine and I do not remember any EMI during the flight. At the end of my shift I rushed off to bed. I usually wake up at 5 to use the bathroom then go back to sleep. My room does have a lot of white noise between my AC unit and my humidifier. Around 0534 I leave my bathroom and hear a loud hum. My first thought it was our N20, then I realized this was louder and lower. A second later I hear a buzzing, then silence, then the impact. I initially thought this was part of an exercise they had been conducting, then I realized we would have been warned and this was real. I prayed that this had happened off base by the dirt road at the perimeter. I put on my jacket and shoes and heard "BUNKER BUNKER BUNKER" as I was running out. As I was running to my place of work I saw lots of people running around. It was chaotic. I started talking to the night shift trying to understand what had happened. After the All Clear I returned to my room. See the diagram for my locations. The buzzing was 50-60ft above the ground. lower than the cameras.

Is there anything else you would like to add?

My arrival was initially postponed due to an alleged "hit" against Tower 22. A thousand soldiers were supposedly attacking the base in October.

When I arrived here I noticed how vulnerable we are. There are no defense systems here and the more experienced team members here have expressed their concerns to our company. They have told the company about a lot of red flags. It feels very exposed out here.

Between the maintenance tent and MWR tent on, the SCAN EAGLE has its wings affixed, fuel is loaded, Ground Control Station (GCS) conducts its pre-flight checks, connection is established with SCAN EAGLE and GCS communication antennas, air speed sensors are checked, UAS is placed on the launcher, air space is de-conflicted with KINGPIN/CAOC (USAF), air space is requested, upon approval T22 base defense speaker now announces (prior to the incident this was not done) "SCARECROW", engine checks are conducted, auto-pilot is initiated, CAT (catapult) is initiated and the launcher launches the SCAN EAGLE, SCAN EAGLE STAMP (air control clearance box) awaiting clearance to proceed to approved flight orbit by Joint Tactical Air Controller (JTAC) at [redacted] Garrison (ATG), then proceeds to "THUNDER DOME" orbit (approved SCAN EAGLE air space operating area, 35 nautical mile beyond [redacted]).

We support ATG with [redacted] flights of SCAN Eagle daily, [redacted] and [redacted] and [redacted] Launch and recovery times can vary due to weather (cooler temperatures are needed to launch due to air pressurization), [redacted] night (on-board camera is not optimal in low-light). The on-board SCAN EAGLE camera is not FLIR [redacted] meaning low light diminishes camera effectiveness during daytime operations. The night camera is MWIR - medium wave infrared [redacted].
Are the launch and recovery times for SCAN EAGLE too predictable? Could the threat observe this [redacted] activity and assess a vulnerability?
Launch and recovery times have more to do with external factors like winds, cloud cover, and camera [redacted]. Small variations in timing for launch and recovery could be beneficial, and I believe that is being worked now with ATG.
Have you witnessed Electro-magnetic interference (EMI) at Tower 22, and has this activity affected SCAN EAGLE operations?
It happens during flight operations, causing GPS failure. GPS failure causes the SCAN EAGLE to go into a tight turn [redacted].

ame on shift at approximately 2355L on 27 JAN 2024. I participated in the Pass Down, went to chow, and checked emails. The 1900L ght flight on 27 JAN was onine to terminate early, and I headed to the Launch-Recovery Site on Tower 22 a few minutes before 030L. I was with [redacted] the other SCAN EAGLE FSR, on shift with me. At approximately 30 seconds from the SCAN EAGLE (tail number 2603) approaching the Sky Hook, I saw the wing lights were illuminated. The SCAN EAGLE approached the Sky Hook and successfully terminated flight when it hit the wire. As [redacted] was holding the SCAN EAGLE, I worked on un-hooking the SCAN EAGLE from the wire. As I was doing that, I heard what I thought was a UAS at a slow RPM, similar to a P09 SCAN EAGLE at idle. It sounded like it was about 100 feet off the ground. I heard the UAS approaching from the south-west, traveling north-east. As it went overhead, I heard an explosion 5-10 seconds later. We finished un-hooking the SCAN EAGLE and started to move it back to the SCAN EAGLE maintenance bay. I thought the explosion had impacted beyond any facilities or structures on Tower 22. As [redacted] and I moved the SCAN EAGLE back to the maintenance bay, we saw [redacted] another SCAN EAGLE FSR, moving towards us and asking what had happened. We pointed in the direction of the explosion, and he left to go in the direction of the explosion. Upon returning to the maintenance bay, [redacted] and I started pre-flight procedures for the next flight because we wanted to get another SCAN EAGLE immediately in the air for reconnaissance because of the attack. We were unable to launch early due to signal interference during on-the-ground pre-flight checks. We were able to successfully launch at about 0700L on 28 JAN 20.

Is there anything else you would like to add?

Yes- I am certain of the direction of approach of the enemy UAS, but the Sky Hook generator was still on during the event and may have skewed my perception of the exact approach line. There was no moonlight or illumination during the recovery of the SCAN EAGLE UAS, so I was reliant on my hearing of the bearing of the enemy U



How does your position interface with intelligence?

Originally, Intel didn't when we RIPd with Arkansas. I started combing through Chatsurfer immediately once we got here. I tried to find chatrooms and learning how to use it. I didn't know there was intelligence on it initially, but after digging into other [REDACTED] I found the intel chats they had. We all use [REDACTED] SIPR Token. I joined all the intel chats and let the other shifts on BDOC know about the chats. I assumed it was the norm for [REDACTED] to monitor these chats. We would Copy and Paste information from Jordan and Sourthern Syria into our [REDACTED] Log. We then would brief the on-coming shift. [REDACTED] would also get information and would let us know. We do not have a dedicated S2 so I would gather all the information for all 3 shifts and bring pertinent information to Mission Platoon and give them Intel briefs when they had convoys. [REDACTED] also received emails from CUOPs (unsure of unit) with intel. [REDACTED] would also give us information. We often reach out to ATG to break down any reports we see because they have an S2 that can give use credibility and confidence assessments. We would also ask them if repeated reports was simply circular reporting or an increase in confidence. Usually it was circular reporting.

Is there an SOP for intelligence coordiantion?

It is all OJT and I have no formal intelligence training. Our systems are based on what I observed other groups were doing and from searching "Intel" on chats.

How did you disseminate intelligence? Who do you alert?

I would brief the last 48hrs as a standard to the Mission Platoon. I usually briefed them everything that happened since my last brief to them. Additional units would join Mission Platoon and also receive the brief. I would alert the [REDACTED] operator when pertinent intel came in. If it was a threat to T22 or ATG I would have the RTO push it out to Towers over the ASIP radio. I then have our [REDACTED] advise [REDACTED] for imminent threats. During shift change, I would brief the whole oncoming BDOC staff of any intelligence as I briefed our log. [REDACTED] usually wasn't present during shift change, but we would search him out to provide an update.

Can you expand on how the alert relationship between the [REDACTED]

It is a weird dynamic because I am in C Co, but as the [REDACTED] is my next higher. I am usually a squad leader when I am not a [REDACTED] Me as an [REDACTED] filling the [REDACTED] roll is weird. Having two different chain of commands depending on the situation is abnormal, but I understand why it is different. Initially I struggled with understanding the different alert structures and would send Ochoa to wake up my [REDACTED]. We then woke up [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED] After learning that the [REDACTED] was not the first person alerted, the [REDACTED] directed the BDOC to alert the [REDACTED] or the [REDACTED] first.

Do you remember receiving a TIPPER report on 28JAN? What time did you receive that and who did you tell?

Yes. I believe I saw it in the Guardian Intel Collaboration Chat. [REDACTED] from ATG was the [REDACTED] and also called me saying SabrenNews 22 on Telegram pushed out a message saying they attacked a base near Rukban. ATG advised us that usually attacks happen 30minutes after SabrenNews posts [REDACTED] advised that ATG historically is the base attacked when Rukban is mentioned. I saw it in the Chat first, then ATG called our desk. I received the phone call from [REDACTED] immediately after I read the post in ChatSurfer.

What did the alert chain look like for the Tipper report?

I called attention in the BDOC and sent the [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] to give him the Tipper update. I don't recall if the [REDACTED] passed information to the SECFOR via ASIP, but he has always executed that task in the past. I don't allow any intel to be passed over the Motorola radios. I either use ASIPs or Ochoa as a runner. He returned and told me [REDACTED] was familiar with SabrenNews, that it was OSINT, and that they are not always accurate but sometimes are [REDACTED] news was to stay vigilant. The [REDACTED] passed the information via ASIP.

What were the orders given after [REDACTED] was informed of the OSINT Tipper? What actions were taken? Was a discussion had to call "BUNKERS" based on the OSINT Tipper? If not, why not?

The guidance from [REDACTED] was that since it was an OSINT report we will just stay vigilant. There was no change in posture or call for Bunkers at that time. Reports increase our vigilance, but it doesn't change what we do since we are always monitoring. I would say that every track is more carefully monitored.

What were your actions during SCAN EAGLE landing?

It was a normal day regarding SCAN EAGLE doing a normal tasking on a border crossing. On their way back following the Iraq/Syria border back. They advised when they were RTB. They became an unknown track when they fell of ATG's [REDACTED] an and entered our fan due to Scan Eagle crossing into a different radar. I was telling our [REDACTED] to PID Scan Eagle when he advised he was already doing that. This is a normal occurrence and we are used to doing this. We used the cameras and radar to confirm it was SCAN EAGLE and continued to watch the bird. I confirmed nothing was following it as it approached from the Northeast.

There were 2x tracks to the south. The first was moving around 4m/s and the second track was around the edge of our [REDACTED]. I don't know how fast the second track was since it was not heading towards Tower 22 or traveling in a concerning manner. We see a lot of ghost tracks to the south from weather, trash, and balloons.

Is there anything you would like add? Can you think of anyone else we should talk to?

I need to verify with [REDACTED] but it sounds like our [REDACTED] was trying to send stuff to [REDACTED] but it wasn't working. I don't know what the issue was though. The S2 never came to Tower 22 prior to the attack and are based out of Kuwait with the rest of the battalion staff. The Battalion also has at least one [REDACTED], possibly more in Kuwait that never came to Tower 22. The [REDACTED] here have griped about not having Intel staff here. I complained to my [REDACTED] but I don't know where it went after that.

Every once in a while, TF Sentinal at JTC would pass info to us hours after we had initially seen it in Chatsurfer. It wasnt very often, but it is more frequent since the attack. The timing has improved as well.

What does your typical day as a FSR supporting SCAN EAGLE Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) consist of?
[REDACTED] and I usually rotate between flight and recovery operations every other day. I either help launch or pilot the day bird or recover or fly the night bird. My routine centers around setting up the day SCAN EAGLE for flight operations by doing pre-flight checks and launching by 0700L or flying the last few hours of the night SCAN EAGLE.
Please describe the daily times for launch and recovery of the SCAN EAGLE UAS vehicle from T22 in support of ATG, and how launch and recovery operation times can vary.

When I was at Tower 22 from December 2018 through June 2019, the launch and recovery times for SCAN EAGLE were the same as they are now. For the launch and recovery times for SCAN EAGLE, we are constrained by Visual Flight Rules, weather, cloud cover. We are not constrained by the Jordanian military.
Have you witnessed Electro-magnetic interference (EMI) at Tower 22, and has this activity affected SCAN EAGLE operations? Does the SCAN EAGLE emit a signal for friendly identification?

I have witnessed EMI during recovery operations of the SCAN EAGLE. C2 down-link and up-link has been targeted, but I believe these EMI activities are not specific; they are targeting coalition activities generally. Generally, I observe EMI at 0700L, and it consists of Ground GPS failure, Aircraft GPS failure, and C2 hits. MODE 3 is emitting at all times for friendly identification. Mode 3 Bandwidth is DO 14A (NFI).

What differences have you observed in the conduct of SCAN EAGLE operations and interactions with the Base Defense Operations Cell (BDOC) since the attack on Tower 22 on 28 January 2024?
Before the attack, notification of pre-flight checks or launch operations was just communicated over chat. Now it's over the base loudspeaker. We also use Night Vision goggles to identify the SCAN EAGLE in STAMP, where before the SCAN EAGLE had its lights on. Now the SCAN EAGLE uses IR strobe. Additionally, there is a new CHAT for everyone on base that has increased situational awareness, especially with ATG. This includes ITC, PED, and all commands (NFI). Also, intelligence reporting, such as the spotting of small UAS observing Tower 22, is in the chat where before it was not.

Describe your shift the day of the One-Way Unmanned Aerial Vehicle attack on Tower 22, Kingdom of Jordan, 28 JAN 2024.

The first half of the shift I was flying; then at 0515L I got the Sky Hook ready on the flight line with [REDACTED] At 0530 I could see the SCAN EAGLE had entered STAMP, with its lights on, and was descending. The aircraft was on a 270 degree east to west approach and was about 60 seconds from landing. It approached the Sky Hook, hit the rope, at which point I was holding up the aircraft so [REDACTED] could un-hook it from the rope so it didn't fall to the ground. As I was holding the SCAN EAGLE and facing to the west, I heard a noise coming from the southwest. Based on the sound, I thought it was less than 1000 feet off the ground. I thought it was Russian. About 15-20 seconds later, I heard an explosion. I saw a plume of orange and debris (possibly structure) tumbling in the air. [REDACTED] and I quickly got the SCAN EAGLE off the rope and started to take it back to the SCAN EAGLE compound. [REDACTED] the SCAN EAGLE Site Lead, came out of the compound and said to turn all the lights off. I saw [REDACTED] come out of the GCS and grab his personal medical kit and run towards the blast site. We heard "BUNKERS" called and then shortly after the "ALL CLEAR" was given. [REDACTED] and I moved to get the next SCAN EAGLE ready for flight earlier than the schedule flight time because we wanted a bird in the air to help with the situation. We had on-ground jamming the whole time we were trying to ready the next SCAN EAGLE for flight operations. We finally got the SCAN EAGLE to launch at 0700 and it was recovered at 1600L. It spent most of the flight on auto-pilot due to GPS interference. I remember "BUNKERS" being called one time during the flight at 0700L. I did not know any of the wounded or KIA due to the attack.

Answer: The COMREL for units at Tower has been confusing to me since I arrived and I believe it contributes to the cohesive lack of support. As the Army Aviation Element, we are a CJTF-OIR unit that primarily supports ATG and CJTF-OIR missions. A majority of the units on the base belong to other command structures (ASG-J, OSS, TF Spartan, TF Legion, etc). My understanding is that logistic support and chain of command for these units comes from bases and TEs within Jordan (MSAB, JTC, etc). Our (DUSTOFF) support and command functions are headquartered at Al-Asad Air Base, Iraq. Q1. What is your full name and rank?

A: [REDACTED]

Q2. Current Position + Army Component?

A: [REDACTED] of T22/ [REDACTED]

Q3. How long in Army, Leadership Experience, Previous Commands?

A: Just about to hit 8 years now. This is [REDACTED] For this deployment I was tasked out from 224. I did not have a prior position [REDACTED] and onto Tower 22. [REDACTED]

Q4. Describe your role & responsibility here at T22?

A: As a [REDACTED] a big one is running the day to day operations of the base. I also act as the C-UAS OIC, Reporting, Training, MTT Training, Force-Pro OIC so I coordinate with others to get training from ASG-J. All air space deconfliction is also done by me. DUSTOFF, SCAN EAGLE, etc. Usually for helicopters we'll see it visually before anything else. For all flights that come out of AAAB are all tracked on THRESER too so no mistaking what that is. I also run alot of the BLS requirements, as well as Host Nation Coordination. I am also the [REDACTED], I track the FEWR to DPW and ASG-J via Troop labor or contracted work. Also food and different classes of supply and logistics support for other tenant units. So alot of BOSI work as well. I have been here since 26 June 2023. My replacement is currently here ([REDACTED]) we are doing our RIP. He is a [REDACTED].

Q5. Let's now discuss your R.I.P. and how that went?

A5: RIP went very well, there was a lot of historical data available. I replaced [REDACTED] He was an Engineer Officer. He helped me understand the Engineer design and systems here.

Q6: What were your concerns during the RIPTOA?

A6: It seemed like a lot of responsibility for one person to handle all of this. There's no deputy to the deputy, so I am the primary for all of the tasks and responsibilities above. There's no Staff here, so reach back to Division is required for action.

Q7: Let's discuss the environment and posture over time, pre 7OCT, 7OCT to 23OCT, 23OCT to 28JAN24? We'll break it down by timeline if that's O.K.?

Q7.1 Command Climate before 7OCT23?

A7.1: There's very little that's changed, what I mean is from how we inherited this place...it was pretty rough here. Almost every man for themselves because there was very little guidance from the top. [REDACTED] vision was to build a little family here, and I think people can see that. Before 7OCT23 there were no problems, happy times, everyone was getting along very well. There were a lot of MWR events and people were having fun. I only came on this deployment because (then [REDACTED] [he pinned two days before we deployed] - he is the first Officer I have ever come to respect and truly see as a Mentor. I have had some pretty rough leaders. Really looked out for the Soldiers.

Even before 7OCT we would see a lot of Quadcopter activity, we have the CCIRs going all of the way back that we reported up. On 17AUG I requested the _____ Radar.

Circling back to Command Climate - what changed?

Well we became a lot more vigilant. We would use our PROWORD "AVENGERS" to have Base Leadership assemble at and then we would push out information and meet that way. The USAF guys also have their own Intel sources and they would help us with that too. We were all really shocked that anything that would happen here.

Q7.2: Did you really feel that Jordan was a safe location?

A7.2: No Sir, that's why I hardly sleep. I am in the BDOC 3-4x times a night. My CHU is right next door.

Q7.3: Was that a feeling that the old leadership team had?

A7.3: During the RIPTOA it seemed like they felt that this was a "safe" location and nothing bad would happen here.

Q8: You've been up to ATG though?

A8: I have been there several times, yes Sir.

Q9: What did you think about that?

A9: Totally different mission set. They are focused on partner training and securing that area/GLOC to Damascus.

Q10: What about the Medical support and systems over time?

A10: Medical has always been really solid. Even the prior SECFOR company had solid unit medics. There was some resistance to get an actual provider and surgeon out here but Sir I'm sure you've seen how much of a difference it made. Unfortunately everyone else...one of the AFCENT's old surgeons was reporting that he was the provider for the Role 1 TMC. The GST is a totally different entity and they would help out because originally the Role 1 just had 1x 68W NCO. Even the old Leadership team was fighting to have a provider here. Getting _____ here was huge, but we only got her around November/December timeline.

Q11: Pre 7OCT23, how did the BDOC look? How was it?

A11: When we first got it, I think it looked very differently. It wasn't very focused. I still don't know where the PLT rotation thing came from, its the worst idea in the world. This team is doing much better but no one had the MTT team come out and train them. It was just left seat right seat for training.

Q12: Please describe any changes or modifications over time?

A12: Well the crews are better trained. I got the MTT out here, this will be the fourth time now actually having them come out to do the BDOC training. 10-15 December we had the MTT out here providing more training. That was the same time the G39 Team came up from TFS to validate radar and detection systems.

Q13: What happened between 7OCT23 and 23OCT23?

A13: We were best postured as we could have been. The Soldiers, especially after the 23rd, there was a huge boost to morale. They were like oh wow this is how it works and we shot it down. Everyone felt like we successfully used the Drone Buster. There was very high trust and confidence in our systems. We started calling one of the Soldiers _____ and everyone was euphoric because we thought it worked. We felt like we weren't totally alone out here because we had a system that could defend us.

Q14: How about the Rukban over time? Any changes in posture or any issues?

A14: Sir I have always been of the mind that you have to keep one hand to shake and one hand at the ready. The activity, you've seen the reports from _____ ..everytime they (Quadcopters) would leave, they would also be last sighted going back to the IDP. I believed there were people with malicious intent there.

Q15: Is the threat or posture there escalating or deescalating over time?

A15: Well we see a lot of celebratory gunfire, things like that. At night with the IR we see guys out in trucks all the time driving around. One of the _____ was on W-2, the guard tower on the far side and there was a pick up truck heading over the berm towards us back in August with a Quadcopter trying to launch out of the back. He shot it down with the _____ and then the truck drove off.

Q16: What do you think ATG's perspective is on IDP?

A16: Well I think they see it as an IDP Camp with some bad elements and malicious actors but ultimately people we are trying to help.

Q17: What was the FPCON/Protection posture when you first got here?

A17: When we took over it was very relaxed, the only people wearing kit were guys in the guard tower. FPCON C with Delta Measures (1,2,3,4,6,8)

We held a sensing session with the lower enlisted after only 2 weeks on the ground here to get a feel for what the Soldiers were thinking and feeling. Ultimately, even though we weren't wearing kit all day every day we were mentally ready to turn on a dime and go kinetic.

Q18: What were the intel or threat reports?

A18: Well we got HUMINT reports all the time that they KH and other enemies were trying to set up ambushes on the road to ATG, things like that.

Q19: What about FORCEPRO over time?

A19: Well we had a unit of MP's here for a time that were a little mini Provost Marshall but they had nothing to do here. It was only 4x guys and ASG-J pulled them back anyways the SECFOR runs the gate anyways.

Q20: FPCON Posture over time?

A20: Well the FPCON never changed, we have always been at FPCON C with several Delta measures. We always keep it at Charlie because we are in a hostile environment. FPCON was set from ARCENT and ASG-J. We would escalate and have Soldier's get in kit anytime we had a high threat window. We would call AVENGERS and have Leaders assemble in the BDOC to push out information.

Q21: How about Bunker Drills before and after 7OCT23?

A21: Well a lot of the units did their own Bunker Drills in a de-centralized fashion. We had done walk-throughs and rehearsals but really it was [REDACTED] that directed a base walk-through together even though it was unpopular and Soldiers don't like it. I do not recall ever doing an actual bunker drill.

Q22: When did that happen, when did he come in?

A22: Well he came in in November - we started running MASCAL drills etc.

Q23: What about 100% Bunker Drills, literally putting every person inside a Bunker?

A23: Well that was decentralized - during the newcomers brief everyone gets the PROWORD sheet so they understand.

Q24: What about 23OCT, did you call Bunkers that day?

A24: Yes, we did call Bunkers that day. The first one was going to ATG and they shot that down. The second one started coming up and immediately after ATG missed the shot on that second one we called Bunkers.

Q25: How did you know about the 2d UAS coming in that day?

A25: We saw it populate on the FAAD moments after the 1st OWUAS was destroyed.

Q26: If ATG goes to Bunkers do you go to Bunkers?

A26: Well at that time we did not, but now we do.

Q27: How many times have you called "Bunkers?"

A27: About 20x times total that I can remember.

Q28: How often do you run MASCAL drills?

A28: We had just ran one three days prior. Monthly since [REDACTED] and C/1-158 IN rotated in.

Q29: What about ENG priorities both before and after 7OCT and 23OCT?

A29: Well originally the priority was the BLAHA drain - one of the biggest priorities was creating a proper drain for that area as that was where the Class 1 Warehouse was going to go. After the new engineer unit came in the priority immediately became Guard Towers.

Q30: What about the T-Walls that are between the CHUs?

A30: Those have already been there when we got here, the priority of Force Pro was mainly ECP and Guard Towers.

Q31: What was the priority with respect to C-UAS?

A31: Brought up to C-UAS Working Group. Every other Wednesday with the G39 and Force Pro from Division. When we started looking at hardening for Jordan, the fuel bladders. The MEVA is a good example, the HESCOs ordered for it were back ordered for months.

Q32: What happened?

A32: Well DPW told us that because we had already ordered the HESCOs DPW wouldn't send anymore T-Walls up because we already had an order pending. Around that time AAAB had the drone hit but not explode sometime in the fall of last year.

Q33: Who runs C-UAS Working Group?

A33: That's the [REDACTED] We didn't get any traction on trying to make these upgrades and the fuel blivet thing never happened. It was hell to even get sniper screens for the guard tower. It is still a critical area and is continually marked as a red no-go but priorities have changed now anyways. It is still not hardened.

Q34: How about the LSS work - what about the CHUs versus the hardened buildings we have now?

A34: Unless they are contracted to do so they don't build anything and so that never happened. We have all of the bunkers in. We have maybe the best bunker design, most of them have the steel blast doors.

Q35: Have you seen the ATG design?

A35: Well its hasty design, even with the breakaway layer. I have been up there twice total. First time was right after on ground wanted to see it. Second time I was invited by [REDACTED] to attend the SFA graduation.

Q36: Talk about the threat escalation?

A36: Well its basically been increasing every single day. The first month was very chill but it got increasingly more serious over time. Seeing Quadcopters and even some fixed wing out on the distance - everything is logged on there too and all of the reports we had been sending. Once ATG got hit things definitely escalated too. [REDACTED] has been here for almost three years.

Q37: What about after 23OCT23? Decreasing or Increasing?

A37: Well mostly Quadcopters after that - November going into December things had dialed back a little bit. Sir I have my activity tracker I can provide you.

Q38: Who does Intel for you?

A38: Sir I do the Intel mainly. We pushed it up to Division and got [REDACTED] assigned as an Intel Analyst for us, he works out of JTC.

Q39: Medical wise - why EVAC to AAAB and Amman Specialty Hospital?

A39: Mainly political issues between the military lawyers for the hospital saying we were not authorized to bring casualties there. We actually cracked that code and got several Soldiers and even some Contractors over to Amman Specialty until they said they wouldn't take TRICARE anymore. We MEDEVAC'd a few Soldiers there but don't anymore.

Q40: What was frequency of MTT training you coordinated?

A40: I think 4x times total: September 11-15 was the first one. Its a full computer simulation training including the FAAD and Nighthawk. Unfortunately we were going off of what we had which was th [REDACTED] so that means we can't get RCS because the [REDACTED] doesn't get you RCS. Now because we have the mobile [REDACTED] we can get RCS.

Q41: What was your experience level with C-UAS?

A41: Sir this is my first experience with it.

Q42: What did you do in response?

A42: Sir I am a trained [REDACTED] Operator I am a big believer in making sure I am trained the same way they are. I will sometimes operate the system myself and work with the guys.

Q44: For the EW and PNT, why were they turned on after the attack?

A44: Turned on for any potential follow-on attacks for anything that came in after. Based on intel and threat with historical data based on the other bases getting attacked it is rare that they just send a single drone. It was preventative at that point.

Q45: How does EW effect friendly systems on Tower 22?

A45: Very little effect on friendly systems because it has IFF Capability. As long as the friendly system is squawking correctly it should not have any effect. We sometimes get reports that it interferes with the JAF radio.



Q46: Kinetic defenses?

A46: Well I made friends with the guys at ATG and got a shotgun, that was the only kinetic defense we had for several months. I asked both Division and ASG-J for this several times.


Q47: How do you do Airspace Deconfliction?

A47: Well everything flows through the BDOC. DUSTOFF used to be Patriot and now its DeadSea. We talk through ChatSurfer about whether they had any missions and where they were going. PPRs (Prior Planned Requests) from AAAB would also come in and I would assign them a PPR number, send it back approved, and CC the Aviation TOCs at both RESCUE and DUSTOFF.



Q53: Why could the SCAN EAGLE not take off after the attack?

A53: Sir I was not tracking that.



Q56: Let's talk about the BDOC in more detail - describe your concept on the 90 day rotation plan?

A56: That's a Sentinel thing - Arkansas C 2-153 IN was the prior SECFOR Co. and thats how they had been doing it. I asked them about it and why they did it, they said that's the previous thing the old unit did and they kept the same thing. Coming from the prior Co. Right after we came in during the RIPTOA we said do not rotate them - if anything definitely do not rotate the [redacted], thats the only defense. From [redacted] o Thunder to Spartan everyone knew that was the plan. Every C-UAS Working Group it was brought up, including to the SECFOR Company Commanders.

Q57: How many total crews?

A57: In total Sir I have [redacted]. There's [redacted] shifts total, 8 hours each, and all three were [redacted] trained. One Crew = [redacted] (FAAD C2 + Nighthawk), Raid Camera Operator/Assistant [redacted], [redacted] SOG. Normally the SOG was an [redacted]. BTL CPT was an [redacted] BTL NCO was an [redacted]. The rest are [redacted] mainly. 5-6 PAX total.

Q58: What were the SECFOR PLs doing?

A58: Well that was [REDACTED] - at any given time there are 3x [REDACTED]: Mission/QRF PL, SECFOR PL, and BDOC/Guard Tower/ECP PL. There was no guidance given to the [REDACTED] that someone higher needed to be there in the BDOC.

Q59: So who calls Bunkers?

A59: Well thats the beauty of it just being me and the boss here - we call bunkers.

Q60: Back to the BDOC, in terms of personnel, how many are there?

A60: Well 6 total, if you add the Q50 radar. So that's 18x total 3x6 crews.

Q61: Do you have any back ups or are those running every day?

A61: Yes Sir there are 3 crews so they run that schedule every day 7 days a week for 90 days and then they rotate to other SECFOR positions.

Q62: What's the rationale behind only you and [REDACTED] having authority in the BDOC?

A62: Sir we tell the [REDACTED] to use common sense so if we're not in there they can call it.

Q63: BDOC SOP - Have you reviewed it?

A63: Sir I sat down and reviewed it after one of the SECFOR PL's was relieved. I have sat down and reviewed it but there was always a question about who was in charge of Base Defense. Soldiers would tell me I was in charge of the SOP but I would say negative it is his SOP. [REDACTED] would review them as well and then the SECFOR PL would revise them and push out.

Q64: Whats an example of a revision?

A64: Well [REDACTED] tasked his BDOC PL to update the SOP and giving credit where credit is due they got it done and to my understanding they backbriefed it so [REDACTED]

Q65: Wait - why was he relieved?

A65: Sir there is a lot of distrust with their [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] relieved the PL about 1 months after they RIPd in. That would have been around Thanksgiving timeframe [REDACTED] he was relieved because he was given a task (clean up and get the guard towers right) while [REDACTED] was out on paternity leave for 2-3 weeks. The [REDACTED] didn't want to make his Soldiers pick up the waste the prior unit left behind so he did a lot of it himself but it was incomplete. When [REDACTED] came back the task wasn't complete so he relieved him. It really hurt the [REDACTED] morale. There's other context behind it but no one really knows all of the full or official reasons. I think [REDACTED] probably had it out for this guy - the [REDACTED] was personable with the Soldiers and I don't think [REDACTED] didn't like that.

The Soldiers of the SECFOR PLT actually asked to not rotate - they wanted to stay in the position.

Q66: Let's shift gears now and talk about 23OCT23?

A66: We were already on very high alert because ATG had just been struck a week earlier. We were not in kit. That morning ATG called out a hostile track and we were in constant communication with them seeing the track.

Q67: Well what does "high alert" mean?

A67: Keep your head on a swivel, know where your bunkers are, and be prepared.

Q68: What actions did you actually take? Bunkers?

A68: I believe we went to Bunkers, I can't remember. Prior to that, we were not going to Bunkers when ATG did. So we started building up a lot more data to see what was headed to ATG v. what was headed to us. That's when we started shifting and the moment ATG has anything hostile we also have to get in Bunkers.

Q69: Did the OWAUAS land on the Jordanian or Syrian side of the border?

A69: Sir the exact border line is contested anyways between the two countries, its not clear but we think it basically hit right on the border line.

Q70: Do you need to take a break or are you doing O.K.? We need to shift now and talk about 28JAN24.

A70: I'm good Sir, things had been in a lull for awhile with little drone activity for awhile. Things were actually quiet. We had just installed the new Drone Hunter system that we got here. That Monday was scheduled for the Engineers to trench the power line actually. I had just gotten back from JTC for a medical appointment. A couple days prior was the 1000lb club event - it was a great morale booster event. The next day we had the Norwegian Foot March with a start time of 0600 with completion at 1030-1100. Its 18.64 miles. The night shift got coverage from the day shift to come in a little earlier to be able to do it. The entire night shift did it. They finished about 1100 and then started their shift at 2300.

Q71: What type of Intel did you receive?

A71: Sir only thing I heard was Sabine news reported a OWAUS attack was done on an American base near Rukban. We get these reports all the time and normally its nothing. I do not recall what the confidence assessment was for that report.

Q72: What did you tell the BDOC to do with this report?

A72: I asked if they sourced anything else about this report but I don't remember what they said or did - no one knew where it came from but Al-Rukban normally means Tower 22.

Q73: In terms of action, what does stay vigilant actually mean?

A73: It means interrogate everything. When I learned they clued the SCAN EAGLE multiple times and not looking at the OWAUS it broke my heart.

Q74: Where were you during the attack?

A74: I had woken up to go pee and my room was vibrating. I will never forget that sound. I thought that can't be the SCAN EAGLE. Right after that for about 2 seconds later it exploded. The sound was like a very low buzzing, it seemed really low altitude. SCAN EAGLE has a high RPM motor that whines but this one didn't. It has a lower RPM and a Deeper sound like a growl. There was no pause in the noise before the explosion, it was continuous. Right after that I jumped out of my room and ran to the BDOC. It was myself, [REDACTED] It was chaotic the guys were freaking out. Once we figured out where it hit we ran out outside, I assumed C2 of the BDOC and started directing traffic. I had the guys start recording on the Raid Camera. [REDACTED] had them turn the PNT EW on. We spun up the medics, GST, DUSTOFF, and the EOD Team. I told [REDACTED] myself and [REDACTED] in the BDOC. [REDACTED] came back and said we have casualties and we got aid and litter teams. I told [REDACTED] I need to go get the freezer ready. As a 92 series, I know how to use them that is what they are for. They are in the back of the LSS area. As I was moving I was ordering Soldiers to help out where able or report to the Chapel if they were injured. I will follow up with my sworn statement of my actions on.

Q75: Where have the attacks normally come from?

A75: Normally a counter-clockwise area West and North, so from the 9 o'clock to 12.

Q76: What about the presumption of safety in Jordan? Do you believe that or think others did?

A76: Sir I never believed that Jordan was safe, we are in the tri-border region. Unfortunately I think a lot of people did believe that and feel like Jordan was a magical safe place.

Q77: Where do you think the Iron 16 came from?

A77: Well Sir I see a lot of intel reports about potential launch sites all around the Iraq/Syrian border. I think in this case they probably tried to intentionally avoid ATG and run a fishhook South into Tower 22.

Q78: Based on your time in the ATG BDOC, what did you think?

A78: Well Sir they have a full BN running a full BN Staff, so its great. They have JTACs, Contractors, Intel Assets, its great. I do admit their Force Pro Officer did reach out a couple times to discuss battle drills and SOPs but we kept missing each other with how busy we both were. Their BDOC Crews did come down and train here once but it was before the crew that was working on 28JAN24.

Q79: What about the Strikebridge idea?

A79: Sir its partially a bandwidth issue as it would drop all of the time. While its great in theory I don't have enough people to staff it and I only have one SVTC in the Command office. We now have an SVTC capability in the BDOC but we previously did not. We eventually found an extra one in a spare container which got us one inside the BDOC and while it has network issues it is set up and running.

Q80: COMREL between you and SECFOR Commander?

A80: I have TACON. That is the Order that we have received. We have TACON over everybody, but only during Base Defense. I can't remember if we ever got official OPCON over the SECFOR. That was just word of mouth VOCO from our RIP. I have never seen the actual physical order in writing that explains what Tower has here and what the COMREL or command authority is. During our RIP they just said we have TACON. I did not report to Sentinel or Thunder, it was all to TFS or ASG-J. I built the reporting chain because no one knew what it was. We have two bosses basically the entire time.

Q81: What is difference between TACON and OPCON?

A81: OPCON you have everything except Admin control. For TACON once the mission is complete you lose them. I'm not sure about the full difference between OPCON and TACON. In terms of the COMREL here on Tower and the other Leaders, its not always great.

Q82: How would you describe _____ Roles and Responsibilities?

A82: He controls whats inside the four walls. Anything that relates to serious muscle movements between units on the base, needing capabilities or higher command intent. Building up Host Nation relationships.

Q83: Who do you go to for what?

A83: If its installation related, Force Protection or anything else installation related it goes through ASG-J, BOSI. Force Protection actually falls under both sometimes I would get the run around from both TFS and ASG-J. They would fight between themselves between funding and projects and we were just stuck in the middle. As an example, it took us 7 months to get latrines outside the BDOC. Another one, the MANTAC cover, we fought to get it for months and TFS and ASG-J again fought over funding. ASG-J would also reach back out directly to IFRCO for C-UAS issues. Sometimes we would go through G39 and sometimes we would coordinate directly through them.

Q84: What was Spartan's responsibilities?

A84: All operational needs - the breakdown between TFS and ASG-J is still unclear to me. I know BG Woolridge was trying to get the MLIDS down here in September.

Q85: Tell me more about the C-UAS Working Group?

A85: It was an hour long SVTC every other week with the G39, IFRCO Rep, and other staff members. It is based out of Kuwait. They had some rudimentary slides about reporting what systems were up, what issues or concerns you had, etc. They'd pull data about sightings, things like that. The senior person would usually be _____. This was a TF Spartan internal meeting. I used it as a forum to ask for additional capability but I never received those systems until after the 28JAN24 Attack.

Q86: Are you tracking anything about a TF Spartan validation or BDOC certification?

A86: No Sir tracking OIR came out and did a validation after a prior unit almost shot down a Scan Eagle. I am not tracking any Division level certification we were led to believe that if the MTT came through and validated you then you were good enough. We were only told after that it is a _____ responsibility - we received no guidance on that. Sir, its my opinion that nothing was going to get done unless something happened - no one cared enough to make any changes until people died. Everyone keeps saying well now you can fix anything you want you have a blank check. I tell them, its not a blank check, my girls died for that. That check was paid in blood.

Q87: Is there anything else I should have asked you, or anyone else you think we should interview?

A87: No Sir, I think you got everything.

Q1. What is your full name and rank?

A1: [REDACTED]

Q2. What is Current Position + Army Component?

Q3. How long have you been in Army, Leadership Experience, Previous Commands?

A3: Infantry my entire career. I made it up to [REDACTED] As a [REDACTED]

Q4. Please Describe your role & responsibility here at T22?

A4: I am the [REDACTED] for Tower 22 since June of 2023.

Q5. Let's now discuss your R.I.P. and how that went?

A5: RIPTOA was in late June 2023. It was a very thorough RIP. The [REDACTED], he went a little further into that area because he was the [REDACTED]. There has been a significant evolution in the base defense posture since the RIP. Quality RIP very thorough.

Q6: What were the concerns during the RIPTOA?

A6: Well back then everything was a lot more simple and so it seems minuscule by comparison but back then the Mode 5 real estate and transient barracks and traffic control for DUSTOFF were all projects in progress. The deconfliction now is just through both TOCs talking to each other and the BDOCs. Scan Eagle is not deconflicted because its a pre-scheduled event that occurs a month in advance.

Q7: Let's discuss the environment and posture over time, pre 7OCT, 7OCT to 23OCT, 23OCT to 28JAN24?

We'll break it down by timeline if that's O.K.?

Q8: Command Climate before 7OCT23?

A8: Sir, I actually pride myself, I have had the pleasure of having about 1000 Soldiers roll through this base during all of the RIPs in the last 10 months. Tower 22 is a bit of a social experiment so to speak given the different units. But here was an opportunity for me to incorporate CSAR and DZ operations for airdrops and Halo jumps. A combined EOD + SECFOR Team with real time feedback for explosives and IED reactions. Every month we had a CALFEX. We had plenty of ammo and ability to train. I think overall it was pretty good before 7OCT23.

Q21: And now after 28JAN24?

A21: Well Sir I think now its partially because of all of the attention we get. The times of the attack are historically overnight. I think we could lower the posture right now based on what we're seeing.

Q22: Were there ever any actual Bunker Drills separate from real world events?

A22: Sir they were incorporated, it would always follow a MASCAL event. So the first part is identify and go to your bunker. Sometimes they would get crowded. After October to January it was every month. Once our new SECFOR team came in it became every 2x weeks. In terms of process we would do both day and night and incorporated the training for LSS so we worked with them and trained them on casualty processing and accountability. The Bunker Drill would include Bunkers + the follow on drill. We would leave them in the Bunkers for about 5 minutes but only after we check the Raid camera to make sure everyone actually went in there and then call the All Clear. We would change up the follow-on drill and sometimes pretend to not have 100% accountability so they'd have to go look for the missing Soldier. We ran these once a month.

Q23: Any other Battle Drills that you directed or Tower 22 trained on?

A23: We incorporate the EOD Team to respond to a downed UWAUAS that didn't explode. Or if the helicopter was hit and on fire. It gave our fire team a good rep as well.

Q24: What were the Engineering priorities of work before and after the attacks?

A24: PoW have always been Force Protection. The BOM that came in at that time was for retro-fitting the towers. For each one they were either rebuilt or major upgrades completely. The ECP build out was another big one. The fuel farm was in the works but it never came to fruition. After January we've had so many HESCOs and T-Walls come in we could do it but previously we didn't have enough. Drainage was another issue. Both our horizontal and vertical were working simultaneously. You'd have the team going out there and rolling gravel, laying it flat, anywhere there was an issue.

Q25: Why do you think the priorities were not changed after 23OCT23?

A25: Sir there was no additional emphasis on Force Pro. I needed more BOM and it was discussed at very high levels and we talked about the building the sunscreens or overhead cover. It was requested and it was a big push to get it from ASG-J. There was a survey conducted for it as well. Shotgun was a big change and the base going dark. Tried to harden the base by changing pattern of life but JAT shut down all patrols outside the base. I also wanted to vary Scan Eagle Times. JAF restricts any dynamic control.

Q26: Describe the threat posture and any increases over time from 7OCT on?

A26: Well that was really after 7OCT. Before that not even ATG was on the hit list. Every now and then you'd see some TIC in the ESSA but nothing significant. During my RIP I did get a historical threat brief regarding a VBIED that hit Tower about 7 years ago.

Q27: What about the intel and threat reporting after 23OCT23? What direction would any potential threats come from?

A27: Significantly increased both before and after. We had a lot of Group 1 sightings and built a Storyboard that identified all of the sightings and reports. At some point they stopped and the activity died down. The direction always came from the Northwest across the road and then circle the Tower and follow the road. Then it would return back to Rukban. We tried to identify points of launch but Rukban IDP is the best we can identify.

Q28: Has there been any increase or decrease with smuggling issues?

A28: Sir I think the early morning fog creates a lot of opportunities for smugglers and they take advantage of the weather. It seems like those have increased a lot lately, now more than ever.

Q29: Turning to medical now, what were the issues, if any? Did you have any problems with getting supplies? What about the MEDEVAC route to BDSC v. Amman Specialty?

A29: We never had any issues with medical supplies. In terms of MEDEVAC location we actually cracked that nut, we finally got Amman Specialty hospital to accept our patients. I think in terms of trauma or combat related wounds had to go to AAAB. Getting here was huge and she got here from TF Sentinel, not sure how that happened but can't take credit for that.

Q30: Turning now to C-UAS - what can you tell me about how your experiences have been here?

A30: Well the MTT was really huge for us. The problem is the guys hate the Drone Buster, so much so that one of the guys actually broke

Q31: What is your experience level with C-UAS? How did you train yourself or learn it?

A31: I did fortunately have the luck to attend a C-UAS seminar in California that was very helpful as well as a JTC rotation where we got some C-UAS experience. In CGSC, due to our alignment with Ukraine I was tasked with being the Ukraine representative and it came up several times that C-UAS was a critical weapons system. The MTT trained me and I have received all of that.

Q33: The E.W. PNT on the [REDACTED] - why was it on after the attack?

A33: Precautionary measure. We always say where there is one there is two. We wanted to turn it on just in case in an attempt to protect us. You have to cycle it to keep it from burning out.

Q34: What is the JAF ADA capability, if any?

A34: Sir it is very poor, there is no night optics or any detection system at all, it is just a 20mm cannon.

Q35: How do you assess the effectiveness of the radar /EW systems?

A35: Well my predecessor didn't even want to test the radar so I was the first one to even attempt a test. We used the Scan Eagle to run tests. The PNT definitely effects the Scan Eagle we learned that during our trial runs. I was read in on the AV system but do not know much about it.

Q36: In terms of early warning, how much time would that mean for the BDOC?

A36: Sir I couldn't tell you.

Q37: How often do the MTT teams come out to provide training?

A37: The MTT came out twice with the last SECFOR Team and at least once with the current team in the first two weeks.

Q38: For BDOC operations, describe your thoughts/plan for the BDOC rotational plan?

A38: Well I hated it. It was never my plan or intent. I think it was originally so the Soldiers could have a break from the austere environment here but it hurts a lot for continuity. They have actually only rotated once but it was because they ripped in in November.

Q39: Describe your BDOC SOP for me and its evolution? Who wrote it?

A39: Well we adopted ATGs SOP so we incorporated some of their TTPs. We also pushed it out to the SECFOR. The prior SECFOR had a big push to improve the SOP. Over time it has evolved and gotten better. It was [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was relieved in place but that was an issue between the Company and BN Command Teams. I do not get involved in their internal personnel matters.

Q40: Describe your kill chain in the BDOC?

A40: My intent is to immediately prosecute every single one of them. Click on the track, identify what it is and assess by height, altitude, and speed, and call Kingpin. In terms of the RCS they look over to Q50 and start working that.

Q41: What happens if its not identified? What does Kingpin say?

A41: Well we do not mark it as hostile we continue to monitor it and assess what it is. Now we have kinetic capability so we look at the KURF and see what the Truck sees. A lot of times Kingpin doesn't help us identify it - normally it will just be marked as unknown. This happens a lot with unknown tracks. If its within 5k and its unknown we call Bunkers.

Q42: What does the SOP say?

A42: Well now it says anyone can call it but previously it did not. Previously that was just myself and [REDACTED] There was no published authority and we saw the recommendations you and your team made they were spot on. We have also copied the ATG model with their Battle Drill. If ATG goes to Bunkers we go to Bunkers too.

Q43: Why was the authority withheld to you?

A43: Sir I don't think it was to avoid a stigma or anything like that, I wasn't worried about the BDOC getting razed in the DFAC or anything. In terms of over authorities I held onto PNT but the BDOC has E.W.

Q44: Did the previous unit ever talk to you about BDOC Certification or anything like that? Were you tracking a formal process?

A44: No Sir I never heard anything like that, it was just Green Sands and Red Sands but we were not aware of any formal certification.

Q45: What about BDOC Calibration or PMCS? Any issues? Synchronization issues?

A45: We did identify that we needed to raise the radar 5 feet from one of the recommendations. Not sure of the effect but I think it helped with the range. We always performed maintenance during daylight hours and if it went down at night we made it a priority to get it back on line. Prior to October the base was not blacked out either. There would be MWR events and lights on at the basketball court etc. After we actually spray painted the entire base lighting red so now its a blacked out FOB. Because we were on a tactical network we tried to tie in the Scan Eagle and the same when the Fury guys were here but there were a lot of issues getting a real time COP working.

Q46: In your initial report you mentioned a MSL 660? What did that mean to you?

A46: Well I think it was just assumed that is what I was always told by the Team. It meant to me that we couldn't see anything below 660 meters. That was what we thought the entire time, tracking now that it is wrong.

Q47: Let's shift now and talk about the 23OCT Attack?

A47: Sir I can't recall the exact time of day but I was in the BDOC at the time. Anytime there has been an attack at ATG I was notified and got into the BDOC. I don't remember exactly where I was. I saw they launched and took down the first UAS and then they identified a second track heading southbound down to us. I saw the first engagement with our Nighthawk. I knew that ATG had tried to launch on the second UAS but we had already called Bunkers anyways. We had a long time, it was like 12 minutes out based on its speed so we had plenty of time. I don't remember what system it was picked up on but I do remember seeing it on the FAAD screen, maybe it was on the 53 at that time. We turned the PNT on but I wanted to time it correctly because the PNT can only be on for 30 minutes or so before it burns out. Really it felt like forever watching it come in. At this point I had ran outside and I saw the Coyote shoot over the base and it made a sharp left trying to go back for the OWAUAS but then it got too low and self detonated. The PNT was on and we thought it dropped the second OWAUAS. I don't remember seeing any Intel or TIPPER reports prior to the attack? The tension definitely increased. BG Woolridge was concerned about and we discussed it together. Eventually we got a shotgun and as a last resort we could at least try to shoot it down. Prior to the attacks everyone believed the drones were not as big of a deal but after that Force Protection really became more of a priority from ARCENT. We got a lot more attention after that and they wanted more bases to get netting.

Q48: Let's shift now and talk about the 26-28JAN24 attack O.K.? I know it's difficult so take your time.

A48: Sir I couldn't tell you. I have been in a funk for days ever since then. I can't remember a lot of it. I remember we did a 1000 lb club, and then the bunker drill, and then the third day was the attack. I remember the Norwegian road march that morning. I was immersed with that. Saturday for us is normally a half day just like the rest of the command. Its resiliency time.

Q49: What about the Intel Reporting leading up to the attack?

A49: Sir, I couldn't really tell you - I don't have Intel here. Its mainly just whenever I can read it. I work out and then get to the BDOC at 0700 for the shift change. I read whatever TFS G2 pushed out but thats basically what I get. I mean we were always in a heightened state anyways here, it's not like we were watching movies in the BDOC or anything. We would get a lot of TIPPER reports that would claim attacks and things and sometimes they were right and sometimes they were not. It was hard to know what whether they were legit or not. I also get ATG's reporting, I dial into their CUB every morning at 0800.

Q50: What about that morning? Do you remember hearing or seeing anything?

A50: I was in my CHU on the phone with my [redacted] and I remember hearing the sound and I did not recognize the whine of the motor - I knew that it wasn't the same sound as the Scan Eagle. The way my bed is oriented and where I was laying I really thought it was coming in from North to South. But because of where my CHU is, there's a lot of T Walls around and the sound could definitely bounce around. The windows were closed because it was cold that morning. Right after it hit it knocked stuff off the shelf and I threw my stuff on and ran into the BDOC after hanging up my phone. I got inside the BDOC, asked where it hit, ordered Bunkers, and then ran to the impact site. I remember the [redacted] being behind me at some point but I don't know how [redacted] got there. [redacted] ran into the BDOC right behind me but he had pajamas on so I told him to get back to his CHU to change. I remember the debris and looking at it to help guide me. As I was going I was yelling Bunkers. I knew we'd have KIA based on the debris, it was just a feeling, I knew. I called for aid and litter on the net. That spun [redacted] up. I looked at the [redacted] and [redacted] gave me a nod and dove into the debris. I raced in to make notifications to check in on the BDOC and order Fracture and Vampire. I made calls to the COIC and started reporting it up but after that it became a blur. The information that flowed in was so fragmented and confused I don't know how we got most of the initial reporting that we got. EOD was already there and all over it and then I ordered the men to start clearing the rubble with EOD in overwatch. I remember [redacted] of Rivers and [redacted]. Once the impact site was under control I moved over to the Role 1 and the GST to make sure the casualties were getting care and medical was good. Afterwards, I started thinking I am going to need BH and [redacted] support to deal with the aftermath.

Q51: [redacted] said he filled out a sworn statement, did you also do one for the day of the attack?

A51: No Sir, I know [redacted] did one but I did not put anything down formally.

Q52: Let's shift and talk about ATG a little. You said earlier you've used some of their battle drills?

A52: I have not been there Sir but I interface with [redacted] all the time. We have a great relationship.

Q53: The BDOC Shift work was 3 crews for 3 shifts per night with 5 total PAX? After 90 days they rotate between BDOC, Mission, and JTC.

A53: Yes Sir thats correct.

Q54: And those were the only crews right?

A54: Thats right Sir.

Q55: What was the formal relationship between you and the SECFOR?

A55: I had TACON Sir.

Q56: What about the rest of the base?

A56: TACON but only during a Base Defense.

Q57: How did you get that?

A57: During the RIP Sir tracking that was the published guidance.

Q58: Interface with other Leaders at T22?

A58: Interface with T22 Leaders twice a week and daily Signal comms

Q59: How would you describe your relationship with ASG-J?

A59: In the beginning it was very confusing. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was the [REDACTED] even though [REDACTED] had no forces. I was very confused by this. Based on this I started sending reports up to ASG-J but maintained a once a month touchpoint with them.

Q60: What about for Task Force Spartan? TF Sentinel or TF Thunder?

A60: My touchpoint with Spartan is with TFS FWD - thats [REDACTED], at the time he was the [REDACTED] " at the DTAC ib JTC. We would talk all of the time and the formal weekly huddle but interfaced a lot.

Q61: What can you tell me about the Strikebridge plan?

A61: I am not tracking anything about a permanent Strikebridge. Our network couldn't even support it with the SWA. Previously we couldn't even run Teams because the network didn't support it.

Q62: What do you think is the right size of the command team and staff for Tower 22?

A62: Sir, I think a small TAC with some key staff reps, some more [REDACTED] and a [REDACTED] is what is most needed here but I think the [REDACTED] rank as [REDACTED] is the right size.
