

Michael C. Haney Deputy Commander Area Support Group-Jordan



Mr. Michael Haney is the Deputy Commander of Area Support Group-Jordan. ASG-J is the Base Operations Support Integrator and Security Coordinator for Title 10 forces in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. ASG-J supports contingency operations and military-to-military engagements within U.S. Army Central Command's area of responsibility. As Deputy Commander, Haney manages, directs, and oversees garrison operations of a multi-mission installation with tenant operations and more than 2,600 civilian, military, contractors, and coalition forces.

Prior to his arrival at ASG-J, Haney worked in the Department of the Army's Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G9 (Installation) at the Pentagon. In his position, he served as the Course Director for the Army Vice Chief of Staff's Senior Commander Course, responsible for developing curriculum for General Officers to assume command at Army installations world-wide. His previous assignments include key leadership positions such as Resource Manager, Chief, Financial Management and Resources for Morale, Welfare and Recreation, Deputy to the Garrison Commander, and Deputy Garrison Manager. He served in Alaska and overseas in Okinawa, Japan, and Europe. He was responsible for standing-up the Area Support Group at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska, under the 2005 Base Realignment and Closure. He also served as the Deputy Garrison Commander in Bagram, Afghanistan, where we played a significant role in closing/retrograding the base for return to the Afghanistan government.

Haney holds a bachelor's degree in Management from the University of Phoenix and a Master of Science in Strategic Studies from the U. S. Army War College. He is a graduate of the Pacific Leaders Academy Senior Leader Fellows program and holds a master's certificate in Cost Management from the Naval Post Graduate School in Monterey, California.
