38th Infantry Division Deputy Commanding General for Sustainment



Brigadier General Steven King assumed duties as a Deputy Division Commander, 38th Infantry Division, Kentucky Army National Guard, on May 2, 2018. He assists the Commanding General in building readiness across the Division by focusing on personnel and logistics functions.

General King's career began in 1984 as an enlisted Soldier in the Army National Guard. He later commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant through Officer Candidate School in 1988. Most recently serving as the Commander of the Garrison Training Center located at the Wendell H Ford Regional Training Center. Prior to that Brigadier General King deployed and served in a dual role within the NATO Training Mission- Afghanistan/Combined Security Transition Command serving as the J7 under the Deputy Commander for Support Operations and as the Infrastructure Training and Advisory Group Chief under the Combined Joint Engineer Directorate. Other assignments include, Executive Officer, 75th Troop Command; Battalion Commander; 201st EN BN; Battalion Operations Officer, 201st EN BN (Operation Noble Eagle II); Battalion S2, Engineer Staff Officer, 67th Infantry Brigade, Company Commander, Company Executive Officer, and Platoon Leader.
